ASQ is the flexible, reliable, and no cost way to assess your child's skills in five key developmental areas: communication, gross motor, fine motor, problem-solving, and personal-social. Parents complete the short simple questionnaires, and in just 2-3 minutes, professionals convert the response to color-coded scoring sheets to determine the child's progress in each developmental area.

BOMUSD Prep Kindergarten Class

A Preparatory Kindergarten class for eligible 4 year olds and 5 year olds is offered this school year by BOMUSD. The program is designed to serve students who are not quite ready for traditional Kindergarten, including both students who will turn 5 before December 2 and students who will turn 5 after December 2. 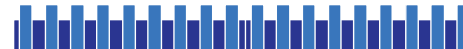

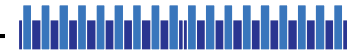
